FORMAL QUOTATION: 1 X 1(one) TON LWB COMMERCIAL VEHICLE

Hantam Municipality hereby invites Formal Quotations for the supply of 1(one) x 1 ton LWB Commercial Vehicle with the following specifications:

A. ENGINE

- The engine must be a four cylinder Diesel, developing not less than 90Kw with a torque of not less than 300NM

B. TRANSMISSION

- Manual transmission, not less than five forward gears.

C. STEERING

- Must be power assisted.

D. BRAKES

- Must be ABS

E. VEHICLE COLOUR

- Manufacturer's selected white.

Vehicle must be fitted with the following accessories:

- 1) A rust proof steel canopy with a full width lockable rear door and mesh protected sliding windows on either side
- 2) A robust tow bar
- 3) An Audible alarm/immobilizer system
- 4) Load body must be rubberized.
- 5) Cab must be fitted with an air conditioner.

OPTIONAL:

Bidder to include the cost for full maintenance and service plan for minimum of three years / 300 000 Km's **SEPERATELY**, and not to be included in the tender price.

Prospective suppliers must focus on the following aspects:

- They must be registered at the CSD (National Database) and indicate proof of their **MAAAO** number on their quote.

- Proof of their municipal services account included in their quote (Not in areas longer than 3 Months)
- Valid Tax Certificate must be included with quote.
- No late quotes or faxed quotes will BE PROCESSED.
- Formal Quotation MUST be placed in tender box at Hantam Municipality Head Office.
- If, Director or Manager of the Company, are in the service of the State or have left Local Authorities in the past 12 months, may not submit quotes. MBD 4 Form must be completed.

Hantam municipality is not obliged to accept the lowest or ANY formal quotes. The Council also reserves the right to make an appointment, and withdraw any advert.

Formal quotations must be placed in the Tender Box of Hantam Municipality Head Office 20 Hope Street Calvinia 8190, by 10H00 on Monday 26 June 2017.

Prices will be considered according to the prescribed Supply Chain Management Regulations and the 80/20 point system as prescribed by the PPPFA, 5 of 2000.
