Bids are hereby invited for the Upgrading of Nieuwoudtville switching station: Phase 01. This tender comprises inter alia the following Works:

Minor 11kV and 420V reticulation upgrades, two (2) auto-reclosers and excavations for both 11kV and 420V LV underground cable reticulation.

Sealed tenders marked, "**CONTRACT NC065/T01/2021 (32722.04): UPGRADING OF NIEUWOUDTVILLE SWITCHING STATION: PHASE 01**" must be placed in the tender box before or on **Tuesday, 09 February 2021 at 12:00** at the **Hantam Municipal offices in Calvinia** and will be opened directly thereafter.

Tender documents will be available from the SCM department of Hantam Municipality on **Monday, 18 January 2021**.

A compulsory site inspection will be held at **11:00** promptly on **Tuesday, 26 January 2021** at the **Hantam Municipal Offices in Nieuwoudtville**. The doors will be locked at **11:00** promptly after which no further Tenderers will be allowed. The Certificate that the Tenderer has visited the site will at the same time be signed by the Engineer. For further information, contact the Consulting Engineers, at telephone number (054) 337 6600.

Only representatives of the tenderer will be allowed in the tender meeting who is:

- In full time/ part-time employment of the bidder.
- Has the adequate experience to comprehend the scope of works.

The following conditions will apply including the Conditions of Tender or Tender Procedures contained in the Tender document:

- Prices must be valid for ninety (90) days from tender closing date.
- Prices quoted must be inclusive of VAT.
- A firm delivery period must be indicated.
- The tender document must be completed in black Ink by means of a ball point pen. Pencil entries

- will render the tender offer non-complaint. Computerized/ typed tenders will be disqualified.
5. The Tender document must be completed on the original tender document. Copies of the tender document or parts thereof will render the document non responsive.
 6. **Bidders are required to provide a realistic construction period, taking into account long leading items.**
 7. Penalties will be applied for late completion of the Works according to the formula stated in the contract data.
 8. Bids will be evaluated in accordance with the applicable Preferential Point Scoring System as set out in the Councils Supply Chain Management Policy. The following forms, MBD 1, MBD 4, MBD 5, MBD 6.1, MBD 6.2 and Annexures C, D and E, MBD 7.1, MBD 8, MBD 9 and the Certificate for Payment of Municipal Services must be completed and submitted with the bid. Clause 2.1 for functionality will also form part of the tender evaluation.
 9. Bids that are late, incomplete, unsigned or non-compliant will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only bid will not necessarily be accepted. Bids per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
 10. **A minimum CIDB grading of 3EP or higher is required for this tender.**
 11. No B-BBEE points would be allocated if an original / original certified copy of the B-BBEE certificate is not attached to the bid document. An originally certified Sworn Affidavit may be submitted as an alternative. No points will be allocated if a copy of a certified Sworn Affidavit is submitted with the tender.
 12. Letter from SARS including **PIN** to validate TAX clearance and VAT registration should be submitted with the tender offer, the Hantam Municipality will confirm the TAX Compliance after tenders are submitted.
 13. A valid CSD registration certificate is compulsory and should be included in the bid offer.
 14. Certified copy of the latest Municipal Account on the address of the business and that of the directors, as per CK1 must accompany the bid document (NB. Bidders may not be in arrears for more than three months with municipal rates and service charges);
 15. No tender will be considered to persons in the service of the state.
 16. Local Content and Production: Only locally produced goods or locally manufactured goods, meeting the stipulated minimum threshold for local production and content, will be considered.
 17. Labour-intensive works must be performed by local labourers, SMME'S, sub- contractors (Hantam Municipality will provide the successful tenderer with a register of SMME'S registered on the database of Hantam Municipality).
 18. EPWP Stipend to be paid according to the rates as per determination, of the department of Employment and labour.
 19. The Contractor must ensure sustainability of SMME'S that will be utilised with in the project, which include skills transfer, capacity building, financial independence.
 20. Contractor must comply with the EPWP administrative conditions.
 21. Contractor must provide a detailed breakdown of the project which shows the value of funding for SMME development and utilisation of local labour as per list below: Feedback must be provided at every site progress meeting in this regard. Where possible if other opportunities exist local labour and local SMME's must be considered. SMME's must be rotated by contractor and monitored for quality.

22. Proof of registration with the Compensation Commissioner, Letter of good standing.
23. The following documents must be included in the tender submission:
 - a. Letter from Department of Labour for Registration as an Electrical Contractor in terms of the Occupational Health and Safety Act, Electrical Installation Regulations, Regulation No. 6(4).
 - b. Original certified copy of the intended Electrician's Wiremen's licence.
 - c. Proof of registration (Letter/ Registration Certificate) at the Electrical Bargaining Council of South Africa must be included in the Tender Submission Certified personnel MV cable joints and terminations.

24. Bidders scoring below the required functionality scoring will be disqualified.
25. A signed Joint Venture agreement must be submitted with the tender submission. Additional Joint Venture documents must be submitted as per Tender data F2.1.
26. The municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/ or re- advertise or to reject any formal tender. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points. Potential bidders should note that all projects in terms of this tender may not materialize.
27. Minimum threshold for local content:
- a) Electrical cables 100%
 - b) Steel value-added Products 100%
 - c) Primary Steel Products 100%
 - d) Wooden Poles 100%
