NOTICE ON AVAILABILITY OF AMENDMENT MOTIVATION REPORTS

Dwarsrug Wind Farm (Pty) Ltd has requested amendments to existing Environmental Authorisations (EAs) (as amended) for the proposed construction of the 140 MW Dwarsrug Wind Energy Facility and 132kV on site substation, and the 132KV overhead power line near Loeriesfontein, Hantam Local Municipality, Northern Cape. The projects include the following:

AMENDMENT PROCESS:

In terms of Condition 7 of the EAs dated 21 May 2021 and Regulation 29 of the EIA Regulations 2014, as amended, it is possible for an applicant to apply, in writing, to the competent authority for an amendment of the environmental authorisation if the amendment will not change the scope of a valid environmental authorisation nor increase the level or nature of the impact. The amendment to extend the EAs validity by additional 10 years will not increase the level, nature or significance of impacts which were initially assessed, and the amendment will take place within the authorised development footprint. The amendment on its own will not trigger a listed activity. An application in this regard has been submitted to the DFFE who have confirmed that the application falls within the ambit of a Part 1 amendment process. A public participation process is required to be undertaken in support of this application in accordance with the requirements of the DFFE requested in terms of Regulation 30(1)(a) of the EIA Regulations, 2014 as amended.

MOTIVATION REPORTS AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

Savannah Environmental, as independent environmental consultant, has compiled Motivation Reports in support of the Amendment Applications. These reports aim to provide details of the current state of the environment and regarding environmental impacts which may arise as a result of the requested amendments in order for interested and affected parties to be informed and submit comments, and for the competent authority to be able to reach a decision in this regard. The reports are supported by specialist site verification and motivation reports to inform the conclusion and recommendations regarding the proposed amendments. The Motivation Reports and supporting documentation will be available for public review and comment from **Wednesday, 12 November 2025** to **Friday, 12 December 2025**.
